Ideally, you are outgoing and comfortable speaking in front of large crowds (mainly the promotions coordinator). Our Promotions Director will lead the team from the Press Box, but the remaining roles will be going throughout the ballpark to engage all fans.

All roles are seasonal, and individuals must be able to attend pre-season rehearsals and all Bells home games (our schedule can be found at bellinambells.com).

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Promotions Director

Our team is looking for a creative and managerially talented individual to join our team. The Press Box Director will run and oversee the entire in-game show, all fan-engagement, and all creative scoreboard content for all Bells Home Games including video production elements and the control room.

Reports To: Operations Coordinator

Leads: PA Announcer, Promotions Coordinator, Mascot, and Camera Operator.

Responsibilities

- **Pre-Game:**
 - Assist in any tasks given by Operations Coordinator.
 - Assist in leading meeting with gameday crew members (PA announcer, promotions leader, and camera operator) for pre-game for run down.
 - Prep scoreboard content each gameday – including sponsor commercials, advertisements, player scorecards, player walk-up songs, all in-game music, fan camera, and all other applicable scoreboard content.
- **In-Game:**
 - Run press box and scoreboard content– including sponsor commercials, advertisements, player cards, player walk-up songs, all in-game music, fan camera, and all other applicable scoreboard content.
 - Assist managing on-field events with promotions team and camera operator. You will be on a headset, running the show, all game with promotions coordinator and camera operator.

Characteristics/Qualifications

- Works well in a fast-paced environment, managing multiple tasks, and has great time management skills.
- Comfortable leading and managing others.
- Excellent communication skills (written and verbal).
- Acts with integrity and is respectful of others.
- Excellent attention to detail and is well organized.
- Proficient in video and photo editing/tech savvy.

- Able to work all Bells home games and attend all pre-season mandatory meetings and rehearsals.
- Knowledge of the game of baseball is preferred.

Promotions Coordinator

This position will execute all fan-engagement, in-game promotions and run the performance of the promotions team. You will execute all facets of pre-game ceremonies and in-game elements, including National Anthems, First Pitches, Inning Promotions, and Dinger appearances. We are looking for an outgoing individual who is comfortable speaking in front of large crowds, can engage a large audience in the show, and enjoys theatrical/comedic experiences. **Reports To:** Promotions Director. **Leads:** Promotions Intern, Mascot

Responsibilities

- **Pre-Game:**
 - Attend pre-game meeting with Promotions Director – receive game duties, review all necessary items, receive instructions, and execute assigned pre-game activities.
 - Lead pre-game meeting with Promotions Intern, Camera Operator, and Mascot.
 - Engage with fans on the concourse as they enter the stadium.
 - Prepare for in-game features– pick contestants, set up props, etc. Thoroughly explain field instructions to participants.
 - Act as host to various guests includes greeting guests, escorting guests to and from the field during pregame, clearly articulating expectations while on the field and generally making sure guests have a safe and fun experience.
- **In-Game:**
 - You will be on a headset, running the on-field show, all game with press box captain and camera operator.
 - Execute assigned in-game features including inning promotions, live shots, presentations, mascot appearances, mc'ing, and other items assigned. Wrap-up & clean space as needed.

Characteristics/Qualifications

- Must attend a promotions tryout to showcase your ability to interact with fans and engage a large audience.
- Very comfortable interacting with fans and large crowds. Comfortable speaking in front of large crowds.
- Positive, outgoing, and energetic personality.
- Good communication and problem-solving skills.
- Ability to take direction, think on his/her feet and stay calm in stressful situations while displaying first class customer service.
- Self-starter, pro-active, highly motivated, detail oriented.
- Drive and motivation, leadership skills.

- Able to work all Bells home games and attend all pre-season mandatory meetings and rehearsals.
- Must be able to stand and walk for prolonged periods.
- Knowledge of the game of baseball is preferred.

Camera Operator/Photographer

Responsible for calibration, operation, and output of camera throughout the entirety of Bells Home Games. Will be on-field, and throughout the ballpark with the promotions team securing live shots and content for Bells scoreboard. You will document all that is happening inside the ballpark including photos during the game of live action shots (fan engagement, concourse, Dinger interactions, in-game promotions, etc).

Reports To: Promotions Director and coincide with Promotions Coordinator.

Responsibilities

- Attend pre-game meeting with Promotions Director – receive game duties, review all necessary items, receive instructions, and execute assigned pre-game/in-game activities.
- Assist leading second pre-game meeting with Promotions Coordinator, Promotions Intern, and Mascot.
- You will be on a headset, all game with Promotions Director and Promotions Coordinator.
- Assist the promotions coordinator with all pre-game and in-game responsibilities including on-field promotions and live shots.
- Coordinates with press box coordinator throughout the game for scoreboard content.
- Responsible for ensuring all cameras are properly set and calibrated prior to the beginning of all home games, tech savvy.
- Monitor camera throughout entirety of game, adjust as needed.

Characteristics/Qualifications

- Positive and outgoing personality.
- Good communication and problem-solving skills.
- Excellent organization skills.
- Leadership skills.
- Experience editing and taking professional photos is a plus.
- Knowledge of Sony cameras, photo editing, and experience of sports photography is a plus.

Requirements

- General knowledge of baseball and the Bells.
- Ability to lift 20lbs and carry camera around the ballpark.
- Able to work all Bells home games and attend all pre-season mandatory meetings and rehearsals.
- Must be able to stand and walk for prolonged periods.

Mascot Performer

We are looking for an individual to fill the role as “Dinger” and join the Bells as the new primary mascot for the 2023 season. You will be the mascot for all Bells Home Games with the ability to attend community events on non-game days.

Reports To: Promotions Coordinator & Intern

Responsibilities

- Attend pre-game meeting with Promotions Coordinator – receive game duties, review all necessary items, receive instructions, and execute assigned pre-game & in-game activities.
- Attend all Dinger Appearances throughout game, participate in in-game promotions as directed. Opportunity to attend non-game day, community appearances.
- Engage Bells fans and encourage crowd interaction.
- Create, rehearse, and execute skits, dance routines and other forms of mascot-related entertainment.
- Work closely with the Promotions Team to develop innovative and entertaining performances.
- Preserve the identity of the mascot without deviating from the established character including body language/mannerisms, attitude, fan interaction, and team representation.
- Maintain and care for mascot costume as well as props and equipment.

Characteristics/Qualifications

- Must attend a mascot tryout to showcase your ability to interact with fans and engage a large audience.
- Positive, outgoing, and fan-friendly personality.
- Ability to work in outdoor weather conditions.
- Creative, ambitious, energetic personality with the ability to motivate others.
- Ideal candidate should be in good physical condition with the ability to wear the mascot suit for extended periods of time.

Requirements

- General knowledge of baseball and the Bells.
- Able to work all Bells home games and attend all pre-season mandatory meetings and rehearsals.
- Very comfortable interacting with children, fans, and large crowds.
- Must be creative and understand non-verbal acting and communication.
- Ability to be trained, coached, and critiques to perform “in character.”
- Must be able to stand and walk for prolonged periods. Ability to run across field for Dinger Run.
- This is a seasonal summer position with post-season appearance opportunities.
